SY18 – school year spanning September 2017 to May 2018

SY17 – school year spanning September 2016 to May 2017

ISBE – Illinois State Board of Education

District – Illinois Public School Districts with Type Codes of 01-27 and State Charter Schools are included. Does not include private or specialized school districts.

Enrollment – sum of enrollment in all schools in district as of October 2017, as provided by ISBE.

F/R – eligible for free or reduced price school meals

F/R eligibility rate – # of students eligible for free or reduced price school meals divided by # of enrolled students. All numbers provided by ISBE.

CEP participation – Indicates if any school in district has elected to participate in the Community Eligibility Provision, which allows free breakfast and lunch to be offered to all students in high-poverty schools and districts.

Affected by Breakfast after the Bell legislation – Indicates if any school in district is required to serve breakfast as part of the school day per the Breakfast After the Bell legislation. Public schools in which at least 70% of the students were eligible for free or reduced-price lunches in October of the preceding year are affected by this legislation.

Percent of F/R students participating in school breakfast – sum of # of free or reduced-price students participating in school breakfast divided by the sum of # of free or reduced-price eligible students.

Percent of F/R school lunch participants that also participated in F/R breakfast – the average daily participation in free or reduced-price school breakfast divided by the average daily participation in free or reduced-price school lunch.

School breakfast participation

The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) provided all raw data on site level enrollment, free and reduced price meal eligibility, Community Eligibility Status, school types, and monthly school breakfast and lunch participation. This report includes public schools that participated in the National School Breakfast Program in school year 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 with a focus on those that are affected by the Breakfast After the Bell Mandate. Private schools, specialty schools, alternative schools, residential child care institutions, and other institutions are not included in this analysis. School enrollment is based on October of the pertinent school year.

This report estimates district-level breakfast participation rates by aggregating site-level participation. For each National School Breakfast site in Illinois, this report estimates how many eligible children that participate in the free or reduced price lunch program also participate in breakfast. By summing the total free and reduced breakfasts and lunches served and dividing by the number of serving days, we calculated the average daily participation in these programs. Schools electing to participate in the Community Eligibility Provision program as part of a group of schools are still analyzed as separate sites for the purposes of this report.

In alignment with the Food Research & Action Center (FRAC) and Share Our Strength, this report sets the benchmark of each National School Breakfast site reaching 70 out of every 100 students receiving free or reduced price lunches. After determining the “Gap to 70” for each site, we multiply this underserved population by a site-specific reimbursement calculation based on their participation in the Community Eligibility Provision program, severe/non-severe need status, and percentage of the student population that receives free/reduced/paid meals for non-CEP schools. This gives an estimate of the additional funding that may be available if the “Gap to 70” is met, with the assumption that all new participating students would mirror the free and reduced price eligibility patterns of the current site-student body.

Select key calculations

Average Daily Breakfast Participation = (Free meals + reduced price breakfasts served September through May)/ total days breakfast was served September through May

Free and Reduced Price Eligible Students Participating in School Breakfast Program per 100 participating in the National School Lunch Program = Average Daily Breakfast Participation / Average Daily Lunch Participation

Summer meal and After-school Programs

ISBE also provided all raw data on participation in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) At Risk, Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), and the Seamless Summer Option (SSO).

Participation in the CACFP At-Risk After-School look sat meals and snacks provided in October through May of 2018 only.

Summer meal calculations include all meals and snacks provided through SFSP and the SSO within the months of May through September 2017 and 2018.

Limitations

Sites that do not have a National School Breakfast Program are not reflected in this analysis.

Only Public School Districts with Type Codes of 01-27 and State Charter Schools are included in this analysis. Schools required to implement Breakfast After the Bell are those public schools in which at least 70% of the students were eligible for free or reduced-price lunches in October of the preceding year. Districts affected by Breakfast After the Bell are those public school districts that include at least one school required to implement Breakfast After the Bell.
